- Support report writing process, working with the Study Lead to produce sections
- Support the development of other study deliverables, including briefs, presentations and infographics
- Write research proposals with supervision and direction from the Director of Research and Business Development Manager.

- Good problem-solving and decision-making skills.
- Proactive approach to work
- Excellent communication skills we have a diverse team and work with a diverse range of partners. This requires someone who is an open and reflective communicator.
