

EMPATIKA YEAR IN REVIEW 2022



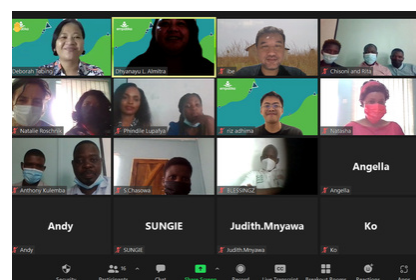
JANUARY

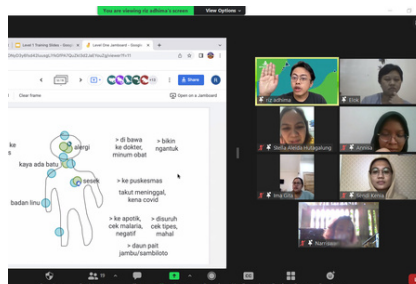
JUNE

- Empatika participated in UNICEF's gathering on malaria programming held in Bali.
- Our team presented findings from our assessment with Stats4SD of a project in Tanzania and Democratic Republic of the Congo on improving access to quality basic education for displaced children.



FEBRUARY

Empatika conducted our first online Immersion Research training as part of a project in Malawi.



MARCH

We held a Level 1 - Immersion Research Training for a new group of Research Associates in Indonesia with 16 trainees from 6 provinces across Indonesia.



MAY

Empatika presented findings from our action-oriented qualitative research on COVID-19 preventive behaviors and vaccine acceptance in Indonesia study.



JULY

Our team facilitated participatory focus group discussions (pFDGs) with groups of mothers and fathers across various sectors in ten districts in Indonesia for our study on family-friendly private sector policies that support children's immunization.



AUGUST

Research teams headed to the field for a first round of pFGDs in Bogor and Tegal for our mixed methods study on lead pollution in Indonesia.

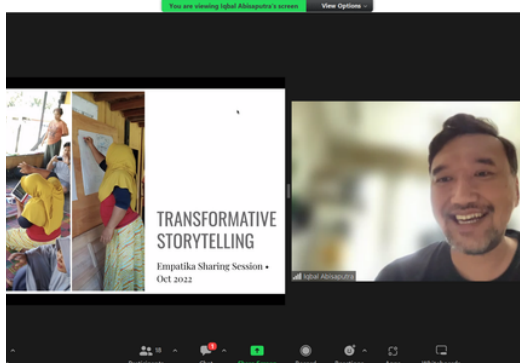
SEPTEMBER

- We kicked off a new study where we will collaborate with Kota Kita to assist UNICEF Indonesia with its roadmap for multisectoral urban programming.

- Our research team headed to the field in West Java as part of the follow-up to our pathways to adolescent pregnancy study to test a new survey tool for Burnet Institute and UNFPA to help quantify early marriage.
- Empatika held a "Cerita Empatika" sharing session for our core team and research associates on the topic of Transformative Digital Storytelling.



DECEMBER

- Empatika presented the results of our study on child immunization in Indonesia during the Immunization Public Private Mix workshop in Bogor, organized by UNICEF.
- Our research team presented our lead pollution study findings to district government officials from Bogor and Tegal.
